Although September 22nd marked the first day of fall, you would never guess, and we really should come to expect nothing less living here in Minnesota with 80 degree temperatures extending through September with hints of it remaining in our early October forecasts. As a result, we've experienced ideal playing conditions thanks to Eric and his team. They will be completing the final phase of our seasonal fall maintenance with fairway aerification and sanding taking place Monday, October 15 through Wednesday, October 17.

We are on pace for about a 2-3% increase in golf rounds played this year, tracking to finish just around 22k rounds for the year. Of these rounds, about 160 of them are donated rounds to non-profit, charitable foundations here in the Twin Cities. As we've shared in the past, we get asked year-round to support some incredible causes around the metro area. While we'd like to support them all, we generally cap these sponsorships to member-related requests and/or events. That said, Dellwood CC donated 42 certifcates for foursomes this year, which average between \$400-\$600 per auction, totalling \$20,000+ for non-profits in our area. We've also turned some of these donations into Club-sponsored events, one of them being the River Valley Charities Pro-Am. After partnering up just three years ago, the event this year tripled its raise to benefit local backpack programs, the WBL Area Food Shelf, and 21 Roots Farm located in Hugo. This Pro-Am, which took place this past August, would not be thriving if it wasn't for our tremendous Member support, as well as support from sponsors and **River Valley Charities.**

Just this past week, White Bear Press Publications released a front page article explaining the increased need for support at the White Bear Lake Food Shelf. Like other Food Shelfs, our local outlet has seen 50-70% increases in traffic over the past year. They site inflation, notably through cost of living and cost of groceries, as the primary reasons for this increased demand. How will they meet these new demands? Through food donations and monetary contributions, which will remain a focus for us here at Dellwood to do our part. For the fourth straight year, we will be sponsorying the WBL Area Food Shelf's Give a Gobble event, where we spend the afternoon delivering Thanksgiving meals to those that would struggle to otherwise have for the Thanksgiving holiday. With the holidays nearing, we will have multiple opportunities for our membership to contribute towards our efforts to support this Food Shelf and our community. Please stay tuned!

Thank you all for your support - and hope your Fall season gets off to a great start.

Fall is here or is it? For the second year in a row September has been more like August and August more like September. Although the weather pattern has been oddly warm, dry weather has been great for golf. With the rapid recovery of the greens (post aerification) we are hoping you are taking advantage of it and getting back a few of those missed or wet rounds from early in the season.

The weather has thrown the maintenance crew a curveball in that we have needed to maintain a consistent mowing schedule. Usually by mid September we are able to reduce the amount of mowing and split our focus between mowing and Projects. Some of the projects slated for this Fall are: building new tees on holes 7 and 10, our yearly fairway aerification and sanding (Oct. 14,15,16), rough grading (holes 4 and 17), re-grassing of the tournament practice tee, and some drainage and irrigation work. When you add in keeping the golf course clean from falling leaves, it looks to be a sprint from here to November when much of our crew returns to Mexico.

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
