#### Hello Members,

November was quite the busy month here at the club. In November I had the opportunity to create and curate a menu with flavors from Spain & Portugal for the Iberian Indulgence Wine Dinner, as well as a private Whiskey based dinner that took the attendees on a journey through the history of whiskey. One item served at both events, but highlighted through different recipes, was the Iberico Pork. This specialty pork is known as "The Wagyu of Pork". The preparation of this traditional Spanish delicacy begins long before it comes to our kitchen in the Iberian Peninsula of Spain, where it is fed a diet of acorns, then harvested. The result is a product that looks the color of beef, has a flavor of rich nuttiness with a perfect balance of salt, and a texture that melts in your mouth. My personal favorite dish that highlighted this special ingredient was the Iberico pork with apricot and aged sherry preserves, Jamone, and pumpkin bravas.

The traditional Thanksgiving buffet and take-out was a great gathering at the club this past month as well. This is the one holiday buffet that I keep the menu true to traditional American items, but put a little Dellwood Chef's spin on a couple of the items. The stuffing for example, is sausage and cornbread stuffing with fresh roasted sage. It was also truly a pleasure to be serving pumpkin pies from our sister property, Sweets by Brickhouse. Yia and I truly enjoyed conceptualizing, creating and baking the pies, both traditional and gluten-free. We look forward to our pumpkin pies becoming a new Thanksgiving tradition for many!

As the holiday season is now upon us, I look forward to seeing many of you celebrating the holiday season here at the club with delectable food, tasty beverages, and holiday atmosphere. The menu for Winter Elegance is currently in the works. Of course, we will be featuring the Iberico Pork on this year's menu. Calling ahead for reservations is strongly urged.

One more item to note when coming in to dine, or calling in an order: if you happen to have a gluten preference, please do not hesitate to mention so to our staff. We have a designated gluten-free fryer in the kitchen, as well as many gluten-free menu items, and are more than happy to ensure your gluten-free request remains gluten-free. We even have gluten-free chicken nuggets!


